"Bonnie's Corner"

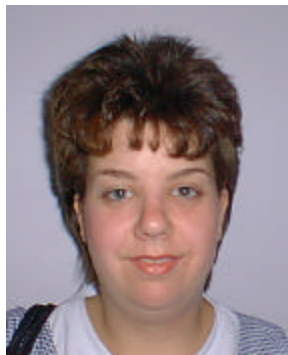
Dear Abundant Nurses:
